### Language Courses

**For students of Austrian universities and universities of applied sciences:**

- Ukrainian (for beginners and advanced learners)

or

- Russian (for advanced learners)

**For Ukrainian students:**

- German (three different levels)

Two lessons every day from Monday to Friday from 9:00-10:30 and 11:00-12:30 with a maximum of 10 students per group.

### Scientific-cultural programme

The language courses are complemented by a scientific-cultural programme including workshops and lectures in the fields of history, literature and culture.

### Leisure programme

In addition, we offer participants a leisure programme consisting of excursions and visits to museums.

### Participants

- 25 Austrian and 25 Ukrainian students
- A certificate of 5 ECTS will be issued by the University of Innsbruck at the completion of the course.

### Participation requirements

**For students of Austrian universities or universities of applied sciences:**

- As regular or associate student (also PhD programme)
- **Participation fee:** € 150,00

**For Ukrainian students:**

- Studies at an Austrian university or university of applied sciences (as a regular or associate student or participation in the pre-study course Supplementary Examination in German)
- or at an Ukrainian university or university of applied sciences
